Driving Directions

IMPORTANT TRAVEL ADVICE: If travelling to the hotel and using a satnav, please search for the hotel name in the 'points of interest' or 'hotel search' section if your device has the capabilities. The reason for this is that the hotel postcode covers such a large area it can be imprecise on some devices. Reading the following directions is highly recommended

The hotel is located just off the M1.

If approaching from the South, exit at Junction 24 of the M1 and at the roundabout take the second exit onto the A50 towards Stoke/Derby. Move into the right hand lane and the hotel is located about 200 yards on the right. A slip road on your right enables you to cross the dual carriageway and you can enter the hotel driveway.

If approaching from the North, still exit at Junction 24 of the M1 and at the roundabout take the fifth exit onto the A50 towards Stoke/Derby. Move into the right hand lane and the hotel is located about 200 yards on the right. A slip road on your right enables you to cross the dual carriageway and you can enter the hotel driveway.

From Train Station

East Midlands Parkway Train Station (EMD)

Head South on Kegworth Road towards the A453. At the end of Kegworth Road turn right onto the A453 towards the M1 junction 24 roundabout. At the roundabout take the fourth exit onto the A50 towards Stoke/Derby. Move into the right hand lane and the hotel is located about 200 yards on the right. A slip road on your right enables you to cross the dual carriageway and you can enter the hotel driveway.
